

(2x) 72"
(4x) studs 2 3/8" wide
(11x) studs
(4x) 39
(3x) 25 1/2
(4x) 23 1/8
(4x) 18 1/4

Angle cuts

(8x) 6' rafters
(1x) 71 @ 60 both ends

Floor 2 3/4"

(2x) 72
(2x) 39
(2x) 69
(8x) 48 x 3/4 thick

Cedar for front porch


(4x) 6' 1x6
(2x) 47 -1/2" 4x4
(10x) spindles at 19-1/2"
(2x) 20-1/2" 1x3
(8x) strips 20

Trims for playhouse

(4x) corner pieces 48"
(1x) joining strip 72"
(2x) joining strips 21 1/2
(2x) joining strips 12 1/2

Assembly instruction



The first step is to uncrate your new playhouse and to identify all the components.

*Preparing the base for your playhouse.
The bottom of the crate is the floor. Remove the shipping legs and all staples leftover from the crate.*

The ground where you will set the playhouse must be flat and levelled.

Cut at least 3 boards 1x6 at 67 in. (more boards is better)

Set them down as shown on the drawing to support the floor. You don't need the boards if you are setting the playhouse on a concrete slab or a deck.

You can lay some vinyl flooring (optional) and cut the excess off.

Before starting the project:

Always use proper safety glasses

Step 1:

Find the right location for your playhouse and orient the floor in the right direction

If you want to have a vinyl flooring, set in in place and cut the excess off.



Step2

Identify the walls and other components

The side wall with the window can be set at either end



Step 3

Lift a side wall and a backwall on the edge of the floor.

note: the back wall on smaller models will be one piece LAC46 and LAC66D

Fasten the walls down into the floor (see fig. A)

Lock the corners in place with nails



Step 4

Lift all the walls the same way .

Nail them in the floor and lock the corners .

note: you should have a space of 25 1/2" clear opening for the door



Step 5

Join the roof gables (if applicable) and place them on top of the walls. Nail them to the top of the walls. Build the truss and place it in the middle of the side wall



Step 6

Set the front porch deck in place

Put the posts in place. Use the railing to find out where to set them. Fasten them into the deck. Take the other truss and nail it to the top of the posts.



Step 7

Take 1 roof panel and lift it on the roof. (2 persons may be needed to do this.)

Make sure that the top of

That roof panel is exactly on the ridge.

Nail it in place.

Repeat the same for the other panel.

The shell of the playhouse is now done.

Step 8

Put the windows in place. To adjust them, move them side to side until it fits properly in the frame. Once you got it in place, use a finishing nail and nail the upper trim into the wall.

Check for smooth operation.

Then nail the sides into the walls.

Repeat for all windows and same for the door



Finishing the playhouse

To complete the playhouse, you will need to

Set up the ridge cap at the peak of the roof

Install all corner trims

Set the flower boxes on the deck or attach them to the wall

Do the joining strips and install the door handle

Congratulation you're done!
